The Synthetic & Rayon Textiles Export Promotion Council (SRTEPC), as part of its Export Promotion Program for the year 2016-17, is organizing its exclusive exhibition of Indian man-made textile products, *INTEXPO Ethiopia* at Lalibella Hall, Addis Sheraton on 6th and 7th March 2017. The event and the B2B meetings being scheduled present a unique opportunity for building long term and mutually beneficial relationships between Indian exporters and Ethiopian importers/buyers of man-made textile products. The average share of these products from India is around 10%. There is a substantial scope to increase Indian exports to Ethiopia since the infrastructure and expertise for manufacturing man-made and blended textiles is presently-not available in this country.
