## Ethiopian Parliamentary delegation to India (22-24 March 2023)





A 50-member Ethiopian Parliamentary delegation attended a short training programme at the Parliamentary Research & Training Institute for Democracies (PRIDE) in New Delhi. The delegation included Government Chief Whips, Chairpersons & Deputy Chairpersons of Standing Committees and Presidents of 12 Regional Parliaments.

During the visit, Hon'ble Minister of State for External Affairs H.E. Shri V. Muraleedharan hosted a dinner for the delegation. The delegation had useful interaction at Election Commission of India and also visited Taj Mahal and historical places in Delhi.





## Thriving relations with Ethiopian...

India and Ethiopia have strong relations, based on manal understanding and respect and sense of genuine partnership. Our political relations have been strong. In June 2022, Indian External Affairs Minister visited Ethiopia. He called on the Ethiopian President and discussed bilateral cooperation including education, health and investment as also development partnership. He also exchanged pleasuntries with the Prime Minister and also with Deputy Prime Minister & Foreign Minister. Also, EAM met Ethiopian DPM & FM on the skeleines of UNGA in New York.

Secretary (Economic Relations) in the Ministry of External Affairs visited Ethiopia. Minister for Women and Social Affairs Ergogie Tesfaye (Ph.D)was conferred ICCR Distinguished Alumni Award – 2021 in New Delhi. In fact, she was the only dignitary from Africa to be conferred this prestigious award for the year 2021.

Education is an important aspect of our relations. Thousands of Indian teachers had taught in schools in Ethiopia. Today, more than 1000 Indian faculty teach in various public universities in Ethiopia. Students from Ethiopia form one of the largest groups of students from Africa studying in India.

More than 650 Indian companies are registered with the Ethiopian Investment Commission, generating employment to about 75,000 Ethiopian nationals. During the past two years, I have visited more than 160 Indian factories in Ethiopia. Indian companies are favorably looking at investing in Ethiopia. Also, India is the second largest trading partner for Ethiopia. 47 Indian companies participated at the Ethio Health Exhibition & Congress (March). Then, II companies from India and 2 Indian companies based in Ethiopia participated at the Africa Sourcing Fashion Week

More than 100 years ago, it was estimated that there were about 150 Indian families in Dire Dawa and Addis Ababa. Today, we have about 50 families, mostly from Gujarut, that have lived in this beautiful country for the past 3-4 generations. During the last 10 years, many Indian investors have joined them in Ethiopia. Today, there are about 5000 Indian nationals. For all purposes, Ethiopia is their home.

Ethiopian Airlines has been connecting the people of India and Ethiopia & Africa for the last 50 years. As an African Airlines that operates in many destinations in Africa, thousands of Indian travelers have been patrons of Ethiopian Airlines. Ethiopian Airlines operates almost 6 daily flights to Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru and Chennal. It is expected to operate flights to Hyderabad. This boddes well, is good for our two countries. It will connect the peoples of the two countries for tourism; will facilitate more trade and business ties between India and Ethiopia & Africa.
